

## **Context Information - Academy**

Macaulay is a large primary academy with 518 pupils currently on roll, ranging from Nursery to 6. ASP 2017 showed that a high percentage of pupils were eligible for free school meals (43% compared to 24% nationally.) 192 are entitled to pupil premium and 21 access Early Years' Pupil Premium.

According to ASP 2017 the school deprivation indicator is higher than the national average (top 20%).

The stability of the school population is decreasing and there is an increased level of transiency due to the large number of privately rented properties which are now available in the catchment area. This change in stability means that pupils are currently being admitted on a weekly basis, many of whom are vulnerable; have challenging behaviour or are working below national expectations.

The majority of families are white British. Only 9% of pupils are from ethnic minority backgrounds compared to 31.6% nationally and only 9% of pupils' first language is not English compared to 21% nationally.
